**NOTICE TO IMPORTERS**

**NO. 6 of 2013**

**THE COMMON EXTERNAL TARIFF (SUSPENSION  
AND VARIATION) (NO. 2) ORDER, 2013**

All Importers and Exporters are advised of the Suspension and Variation of Customs Duty of the Common External Tariff (CET) in respect of in respect of certain **medicaments**.

The suspension of the rate of Duty on medicaments has been published as the Common External Tariff (Suspension) (No. 2) Order, 2013 vide **Legal Notice No. 21 of 2013**, and the varied rate of Duty published as the Common External Tariff (Variation of Duty)

Pursuant to these Legal Notices **all** medicaments **entered** during the period **February 1<sup>st</sup> 2013, (date of publication of the Legal Notices) to June 8<sup>th</sup> 2016**, under Tariff Heading **30:04, excluding the list of medicaments enumerated in the Schedules of the aforementioned Legal Notices Nos. 21 and 22 and of 2013** shall be admitted **free of Customs Duty** and that those medicaments appearing in the said Schedules, will continue to attract Duty at the prescribed rate as set out in the Common External Tariff.

Additionally, paragraph 3 of both Legal Notices Nos. 21 and 22 of 2013 has **revoked Legal Notices Nos. 306 and 307 of 2012** and consequently, **Notice to Importers No. 8 of 2012 has also been revoked.**

Importers are to be guided accordingly.
