THE SUBMISSION OF CLAIMS TO SHIPPING AGENTS FOR SERVICES RENDERED

All Shipping Agents are hereby advised that the Customs and Excise Division and the Shipping Association of Trinidad and Tobago has agreed that effective April 15, 2007, members of <u>the Shipping Association of Trinidad and Tobago shall</u> ensure that all claims are settled within fourteen (14) days of receipt of such claims.

In addition, in order to ensure that the members receive claims in sufficient time to recover costs from their principals where necessary, <u>all claims for services</u> <u>rendered must be received by Agents no later than one (1) month after their service has been performed.</u>

Agents shall forward to the Comptroller of Customs & Excise, any claims received after the deadline which remain unpaid and the Comptroller <u>will</u> <u>then</u> consider these claims to be invalid.
