NOTICE TO TERMINAL OPERATORS

The Terminal Operators of all Ports are advised that under Section 63, 64, 66 and 207 of the Customs Act, Chap. 78.01 the Customs & Excise Division is given the authority to search all persons, packages and vehicles entering or leaving a Customs Area.

The following signage, with dimensions 54 inches by 16 inches with letters 3 inches in size, will be permanently placed at the entrance and exit points to all Customs Areas:

STOP CUSTOMS AREA CHECK POINT

All persons, packages and vehicles entering or leaving this Area are subject to search by Customs

Any person driving or conducting a carriage who refuses to stop or allow such examination when required by an Officer shall incur a penalty.
